SGC Summer Camp

SGC camp held the first week of August each year and is a working and learning camp established to prepare the girls for that season's music and behaviorally for future tours and festivals. Camp is organized by the Parent Auxiliary and the chaperones are parent volunteers. Attendance is expected for all choristers in Prime Voci, Cantamus, and Allegra and Dr. Wright must review any requests to be excused.

Currently camp is held at Ft. Flagler and is a wonderful setting in which the girls can learn how to be responsible for themselves as they move through a concentrated rehearsal schedule each day. In addition they learn how to succeed within the clear framework the chaperones provide, again setting a foundation for future travel opportunities. SGC staff is hired to provide music theory, site singing, a variety of rehearsals throughout the day, as well elective options. Between the classes and in the evenings the chaperones provide activities for the girls to have fun and get to know each other.

To help the first time choir campers have the best possible experience we have instituted a Camp Sister program. This program helps to orient the girls who have not been to camp before and helps to establish relationships between girls from different choir levels.
