### **Fundraisers**

The Parent Auxiliary helps facilitate several annual fundraising opportunities. We are constantly looking for new ways to support the girls and their families so that they may participate fully in all the events sponsored for the various choir levels. The following is a list of our current fundraising activities:

- **Raffle** – Our first, of what we hope to be many, was launched spring 2006 with the drawing to be held at the Spring Concert in early June. Our prizes are simply cash so that anyone locally or out of state can purchase raffle tickets from the girls. The raffle price is set so that 50% of the ticket sale can be credited to the chorister's Guild account to be applied toward future Guild sponsored events.
- **Boutique** –offers a limited variety of logo items for sale at concerts/events.
- **Holiday Basket Silent Auction** – Families are encouraged to donate gift baskets and other items to our silent auction. 50% of the money earned by the item they donate goes to their chorister's account and the remaining 50% is donated to our new Tour Fund which we hope will be able to provide scholarship support in the future.
- **Chinook Books** – In the fall we provide Chinook Book coupon books to families to sell. 50% of the cost of the book is donated back to us from the Chinook Book program and those dollars are credited to your chorister's Guild account for future use toward Guild sponsored events.
